Takeaway Messages

Never assume something is not achievable because a person has a visually impairment.



Remember, no two people with visually impairments are the same, so just because something works for one, it does not necessarily follow that it will work for another.



A well-educated workforce, modern technology and a wide range of services and adapted equipment, have greatly increased inclusivity.



If you are positive and confident, you should be able to support blind and partially sighted people in an effective way and the chances are you will develop a good relationship.
