Coach Criteria: Making the most of being in the room!

We are extremely keen to ensure that the coaches who engage in the Female Coach Connectivity Events maximise the experience.

We know that in cross sport learning experiences having a common context is essential to ensure a focused and positive experience. We appreciate that you know your coaches better than we do as well as the challenges and needs of your Talent Pathway.

The four events are targeting coaches who work within the Talent Pathway regularly, in that they coach for an extended duration of time, building relationships with staff and athletes. Whilst we don't want to create a 'box' or cookie cutter for the coach they are likely to be working within a regional or national environment within the pathway. This may be as a Head, Lead, Assistant or Skills Coach, directly within your pathway environment or identified as a 'feeder'. To assist you to select the appropriate coaches to maximise the experience we have provided a few examples.

- National Age Group Assistant Coach within the Talent Pathway
- Head Coach of a National League team (with athletes within your Talent Pathway)
- Lead age group coach within a Regional Squad
- Club coach who works with athletes and consistently contributes athletes to your Talent Pathway.

The coach will be coaching regularly talented athletes and needs to consider the holistic development of athletes and the learning development environment.
